



MARANGU VILLAGE VISIT


Start your trip at the Chagga cave - This is under a typical Chagga homestead, set on a banana plantation - Mbege, also known as banana beer is a traditional brew of the Chagga people. Later descend a steep ladder into the tunnel which was carved out to protect the livestock and women from Maasai raids.

The tunnel which is wide enough for the tall Maasai, suddenly narrows and it was here that the Chagga were waiting with their spears to kill the marauders (it is said that the Maasai believe that all the cattle in the world are theirs by right). After lunch, you can visit the outdoor Chagga Museum, where you will see traditional Chagga huts, tools, and artifacts, and walk to the nearby waterfalls

MATERUNI DAY TRIP

Start your mini-adventure with the short but fascinating drive from Moshi up the lush slopes of Mount Kilimanjaro to the village of Materuni approximately 1,800 m above sea level. The mountain waters fall straight down in a shimmering curtain to splash in the rippling pool where you can float, take a swim, and chill out as these are pure mountain waters and not yet heated by the sun.


ARUSHA COFFEE ESTATE

MOUNTAIN BIKING USA RIVER AND TENGERU VILLAGES

This is a short and easy 2-hour ride mainly on single-track trails through the farming villages on the outskirts of Arusha. Most of this ride is flat and the tracks are moderate to good. You will encounter local Tanzanian farmers, kids, and general farming communities. The ride is partly shaded. An experienced mountain biking guide leads the ride.

Experience local cultures from your bike on a 3-hour mountain bike ride through the farming village of Mto Wa Mbu. You visit local farms, schools, churches, milling machines a local bar and enjoy the sights and sounds of this vibrant village. This is a great opportunity to see local people, wildlife, amazing areas, and scenery. Once through the village, you cycle out onto the lake shore where there are stunning vistas of the lake, the Rift Valley Wall, and small herds of wildlife.

TUK TUK TOUR

For guests who don't have time, energy, or the ability to walk, do a village tour on Tuk Tuk motorbike. Being light, small and easy to ride this vehicle is ideal to get between farms and local houses. A Tuk Tuk can carry up to three passengers on a bench seat behind a driver and a guide. Our guide will either drive the vehicle or will be inside the vehicle to make sure you enjoy this experience.

TREETOP WALKWAY MANYARA

This 370m airwalk starts with a short board walk that gradually rises from ground level up through the canopy of the forest. You walk over a series of suspension bridges with thick netting on the sides and reach a height of 18m off the ground. Each of the bridges ends on a viewing deck situated around tree trunks. These treetop platforms are perfect places to stop and enjoy life in the canopy amongst butterflies, monkeys, and birds.

MANYARA CANOEING

During these 2,5 hours of canoeing on Lake Manyara, you get a unique perspective on Tanzanian wildlife and landscape. A well-trained guide will accompany the safari. He will ensure your safety and enjoyment while explaining more about the natural history of Manyara and its surroundings. The best way to make this activity work is to have your guide take you on a game drive as normal and meet our guides at the Endala picnic site either in the morning or the afternoon. Your guide can pick you up a few hours later at Msasa lake viewpoint. Nb. The water level in the lake needs to be sufficient.

This experience is completely different from a day safari. A whole new world of animal species (nocturnal) awaits you. The less seen animals are generally active at night and Lake Manyara National Park is full of them! Porcupines, genets, and civet cats are frequent visitors to the forest as also hippos, lions, and leopards. Our guides will explain the animal movements in the night and all the different species. After the night game drive, we can either bring you back to the gate where your safari driver picks you up or take you to Serena Manyara Lodge.

WALK TO WATERFALL LAKE NATRON

This walk winds up through a shady gorge (very welcome in the heat) between steep cliffs. There's a bit of gentle scrambling involved, and you'll also cross the river a few times. However, after a few hours, you'll reach a beautiful natural swimming pool surrounded by steep rock walls showered by cascades of spring water and overlooked by palm trees. We didn't mind getting a little wet, and so loved this walk and the swim at the bottom of the falls.

Crater, which is 6000m wide and 300m wide. Among other animals, you will see buffalo, bushbuck, a variety of antelope, and blue monkeys. Birds are in abundance. A deep soda lake covers a large part of the crater floor. There is a track to the crater floor and one around the rim of the crater. On a nice, clear day, one can see Mt Oldoinyo Lengai, Lake Natron, and Mt Kilimanjaro. The scenery is left to your imagination! A day trip to Olmoti is available (weather and road permitting) ex-Ngorongoro as an add-on to regular safaris.

Close to the Nainokanoka village, also North-East of the Ngorongoro crater, lies this sunken crater. A visit to Olmoti is only possible by foot with the escort of an armed ranger. It takes about 35 minutes to walk to the rim of this shallow crater. Lots of different species of antelope can be found here. A walk to the waterfalls of the Munge River is also interesting. A day trip to Olmoti is available (weather and road permitting) ex-Ngorongoro as an add-on to regular safaris.

The Ngorongoro Crater rim walk normally takes two hours, and starts from Lemala Gate located about 4 kilometers to the northwest of Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge. The nature trail is confined to the eastern rim of the crater, and the walk from Lemala Gate takes a southeast direction as if returning to Ngorongoro Sopa. This is a forested area, excellent for botanical and bird-watching experiences. Occasionally visitors would encounter buffalos and elephants along the trail as well as Maasai cattle herders. The destination of this walk is the Quarry Hill (2365metres) which offers an excellent view of the crater floor. This is a leisurely walk and would normally continue on to the junction of the main road to Ngorongoro Sopa, a kilometer up from the Quarry Hill, where a vehicle and driver would be waiting to meet them. Rarely though some visitors would choose to continue walking all the way to Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge about 2 kilometers further up, a bit strenuous walk. So the walk can take about 2 hours from Lemala Gate to the pick-up point at the main road junction, or 3 hours if one continues up to Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge

SERENGETI BALLOON FLIGHT

When you arrive, you will meet your pilot and witness your balloon being inflated and prepared for launch. After a thorough safety briefing and demonstration of boarding and landing position, you board your balloon and lift off! Rising as the sun rises your balloon floats in whatever direction the winds of the day are heading over this wonderful area. It is an adventure - even for us. Whereas we know where we have started, we genuinely do not know where we will land as we float in the direction of and speed of the wind.

Your pilot will use varying altitudes and layers of air to navigate the balloon over this amazing area. Each day is different, some of the flights may be low, offering a different perspective and at other times your balloon may climb to 1000' or more. Nobody can predict, no two flights are ever the same and your balloon safari will be unique. While impossible to guarantee particular animals, you are likely to see various species from above. Your pilot knows the area well and is also a committed conservationist and will point out animals, birds, and features of interest. Fly for about an hour, depending on conditions.
