STONE TOWN CITY TOUR

Embark on a captivating 2 hour walking tour through the enchanting narrow streets of Zanzibar. This immersive experience leads you through the legendary Stone Town, a place where history seems frozen in time. Explore iconic landmarks such as Hamamni Persian Baths, the former slave market of the East African Slave Trade, and the historic Arab Fort, among others.. The architectural style of Stone town buildings is a unique mixture of various influences and culture. You will see Zanzibar's bustling market, winding alleyways, ornately carved and studded doors, two cathedrals and countless mosques! Stone Town has some excellent gifts shops with plenty of souvenirs and handicrafts to choose from.

PRISON ISLAND TOUR

Once you step onto the island, you'll have the chance to both feed and interact with the tortoises. If you find the time, consider taking a leisurely stroll through the lush forested interior, where you'll encounter a diverse array of wildlife, including colorful peacocks, bats, and exquisite butterflies. Be on the lookout for the shy and elusive uikers, a unique tiny antelope species as well. The entire tour typically lasts around 5 hours, comprising 2 hours on the road from your hotel to Stone Town, a 1-hour boat ride from Stone Town to the island, and 2 hours dedicated to exploring the island itself. Pick-up times are available at 9:00 in the morning and 13:00 in the afternoon.

MARINE TURTLES TOUR & KENDWA BEACH RELAXATION

Nungwi established a turtle sanctuary nestled in a spacious natural tidal pool close to the lighthouse. Since its inception, this initiative has provided these remarkable sea creatures with a level of protection against hunting and consumption. The sanctuary is home to turtles of various species and sizes. If fishermen accidentally catch a turtle in their nets, they bring it to the sanctuary for care and rehabilitation. Similarly, turtle eggs found on the beach are carefully relocated here to ensure a safe hatching environment. A significant event that marks the calendar every February is a collaborative effort involving local residents, tourists, hotels, dive centers, and conservationists. Together, they work diligently to assist hundreds of hatchlings in their courageous journey across the beach and into the vast open sea. This heartwarming experience is a highlight of the year, demonstrating the commitment to sea turtle conservation. Following your visit to the sanctuary, you can unwind and enjoy the beautiful Kendwa beach.

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JOZANI FOREST

This forest is among one of the world's few remaining sanctuaries for the red colobus monkey. Covering an expansive 2,512 hectares (6,207 acres), it earned the designation of a nature reserve back in the 1960s.

Jozani boasts an exceptional nature trail with knowledgeable and well-trained guides. It's advisable to wear appropriate footwear for the tour.
